Tips for Student Success

Create a support system

Creating a support system - a group of people who can offer encouragement and guidance - is one of the most important things a student can do.

"Having that sense of belonging and community has a huge impact on student success and retention," said Deborah Toopetlook, director of Rural Student Services at the University of Alaska Fairbanks.

Here are some easy ways students can begin building a support system:

- Make personal connections with advisors, professors and other university staff members. For example, make an appointment with your advisor, and introduce yourself to your professor after class.
- Get involved in healthy, positive activities, such as sports or Native student clubs.
- Get out of your dorm room. Find a public place on campus where you can interact with other students.

- Find a returning student who is willing to act as your "mentor" by showing you around campus, accompanying you to the financial aid office, or simply answering questions about college life.
