In the last academic year, we awarded 565 scholarships totaling \$465,237. In light of that, we significantly increased our scholarship amounts in fall 2015.

Full-Time Basic:	\$1,200
Part-Time Basic:	\$800
Competitive – Undergraduate or less	\$5,000
Competitive – Graduate	\$7,000
Competitive – Doctorate	\$9,000
Short-Term Vocational	Up to \$1,000
Advanced College Credit (for high school students)	Up to \$400

Are You Eligible?

To be eligible for a Doyon Foundation scholarship, you must:

- Be enrolled to Doyon, Limited or be the child of an original enrollee
 - Be accepted to an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school
- Maintain a minimum GPA and be enrolled in a minimum number of credits

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES

- March 15 Basic scholarships for summer semester
- May 15 Basic scholarships for the fall semester and annual competitive scholarships for the academic year
- November 15 Basic scholarships for spring
- Short-term vocational and advanced college credit scholarship applications are accepted year-round.

LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION

Our language revitalization program focuses on nine of the 10 Doyon region languages, which are all severely to critically endangered. We were pleased to hire Foundation alumnus Allan Hayton as our new program director in 2015. We also finalized a language revitalization program strategic plan, which will guide our efforts to ensure that children in the future will know their language. A copy of the plan is available on our website.

Language Revitalization Grants

We are currently accepting proposals for \$5,000 grants to support language revitalization projects. Doyon region tribal governments/tribal councils/communities; not-for-profit Alaska Native organizations, societies and community groups; and Alaska Native cultural, educational and recreational organizations/centers are eligible to apply. The deadline to submit a proposal is February 12, 2016 at 5 p.m. The application is available on our website.
