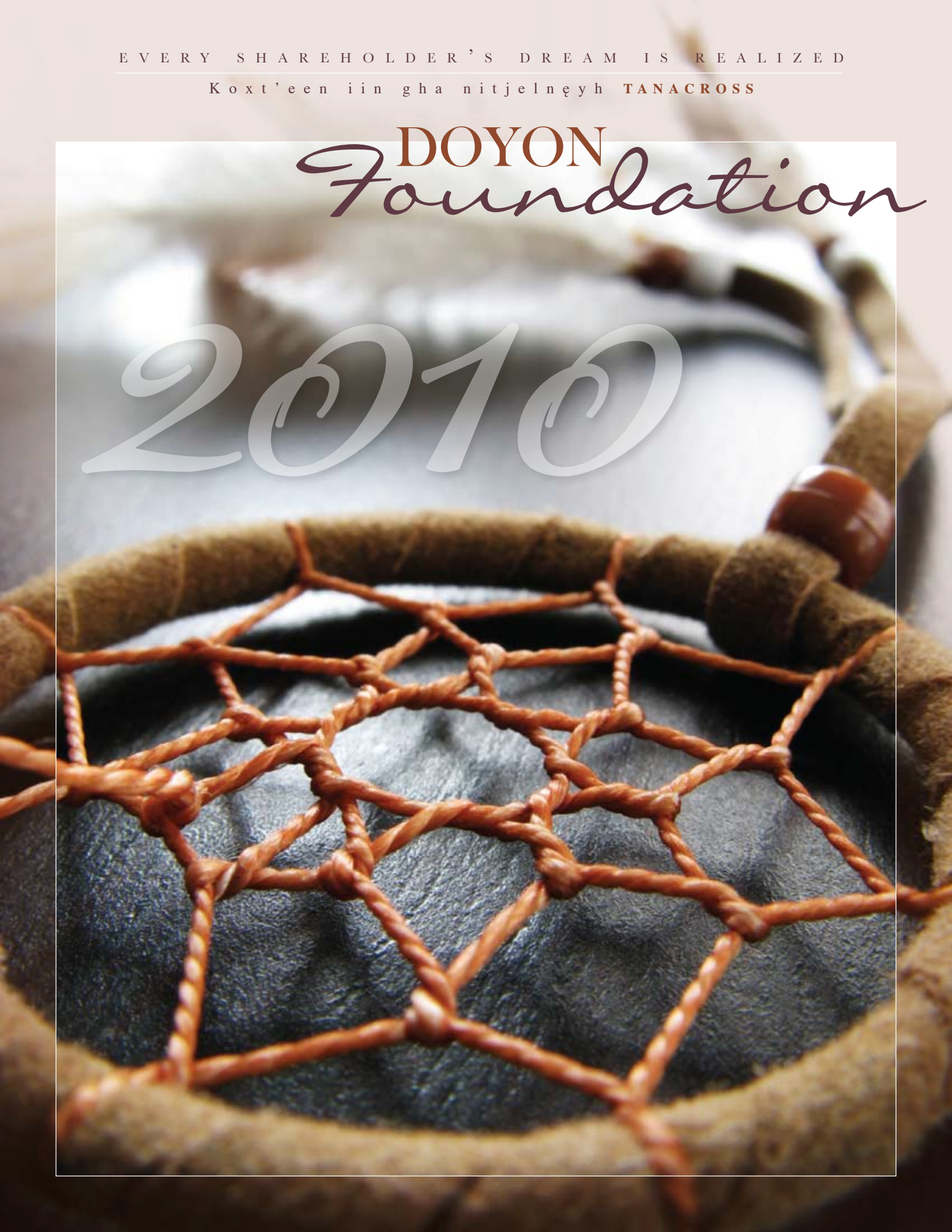

And we continued our student outreach efforts, in partnership with the Doyon Foundation Alumni Association.

Realizing Her Dreams



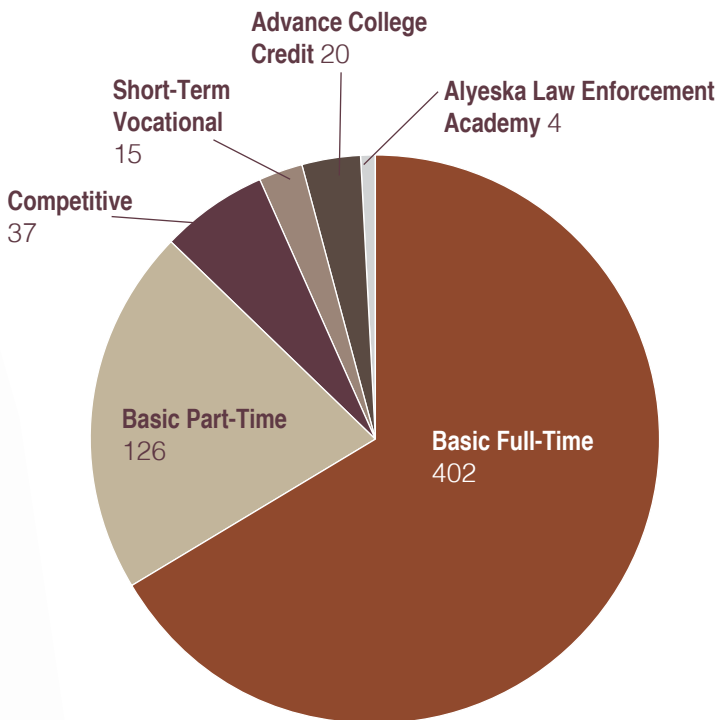

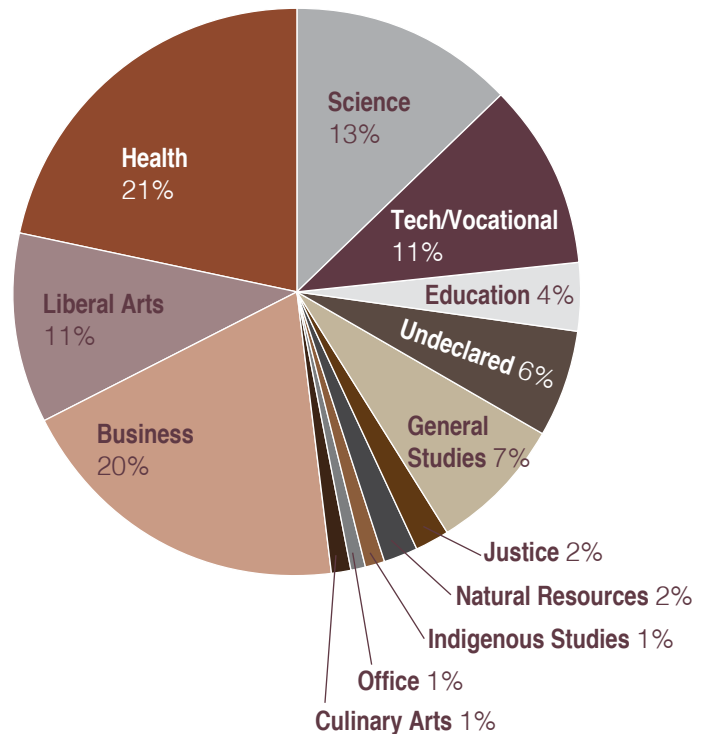

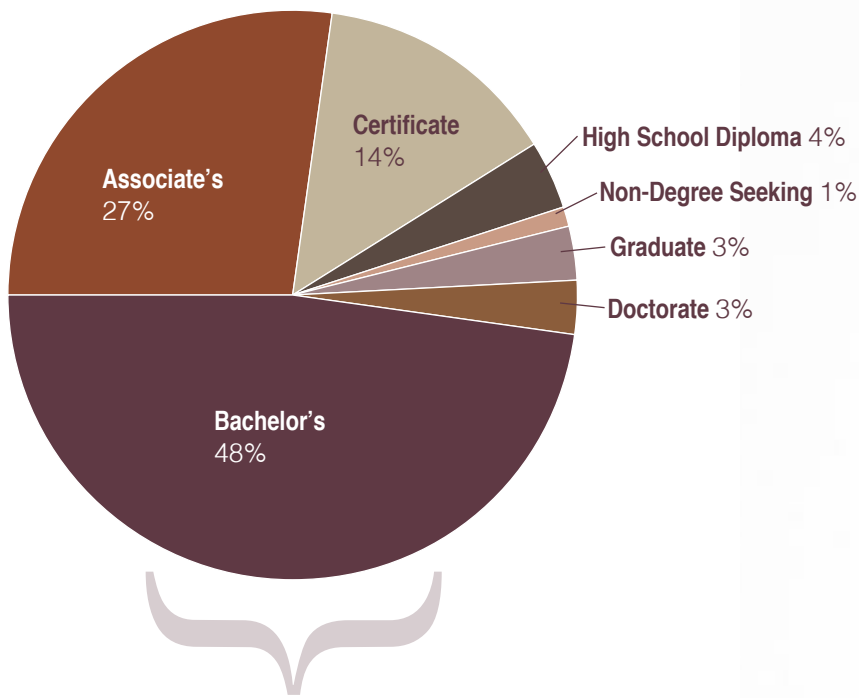
2009 – 2010 AWARD TYPES



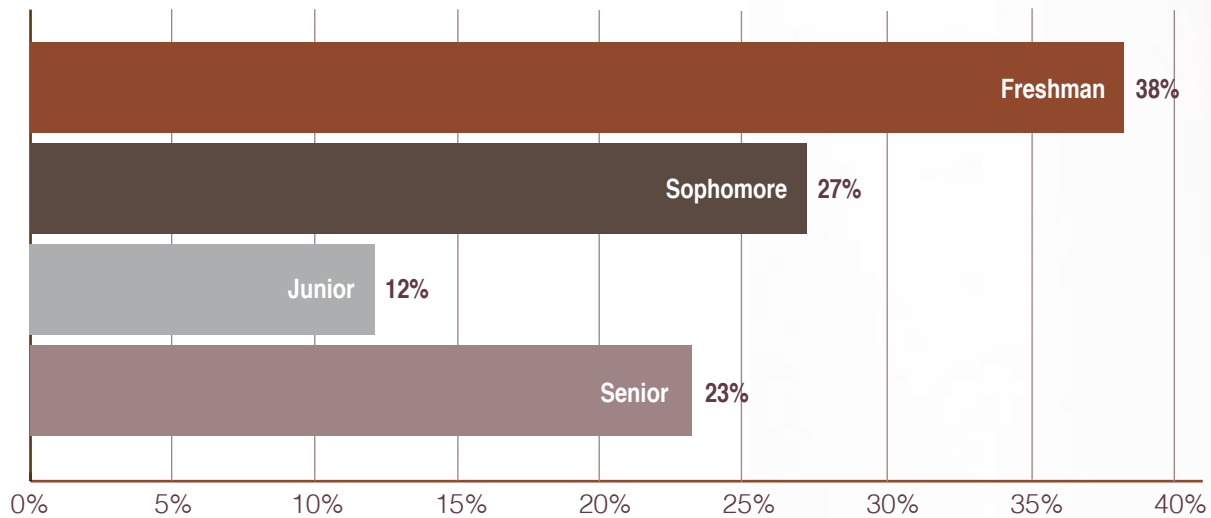
2009 – 2010 FIELDS OF STUDY

MORRIS THOMPSON MEMORIAL GOLF CLASSIC

The Morris Thompson Memorial Golf Classic is Doyon Foundation's major annual fundraiser. We celebrated the 10th anniversary of this special event in 2010, drawing 88 golfers and more than 50 sponsors, and raising a total of \$44,000.

We established the golf classic in honor of the late Morris Thompson, who served as the president/CEO of Doyon, Limited from 1985 until his passing in 2000. Proceeds from the classic support the Morris Thompson Scholarship Fund, an endowed fund benefitting higher education students studying business management and leadership.

Since inception, we have awarded 56 Morris Thompson scholarships totaling \$121,400. We thank the more than 130 volunteers and more than 160 sponsors who have supported the golf classic during the past 10 years.

The 11th annual golf classic will be held June 16 – 17, 2011 at the Chena Bend Golf Course on Fort Wainwright in Fairbanks.

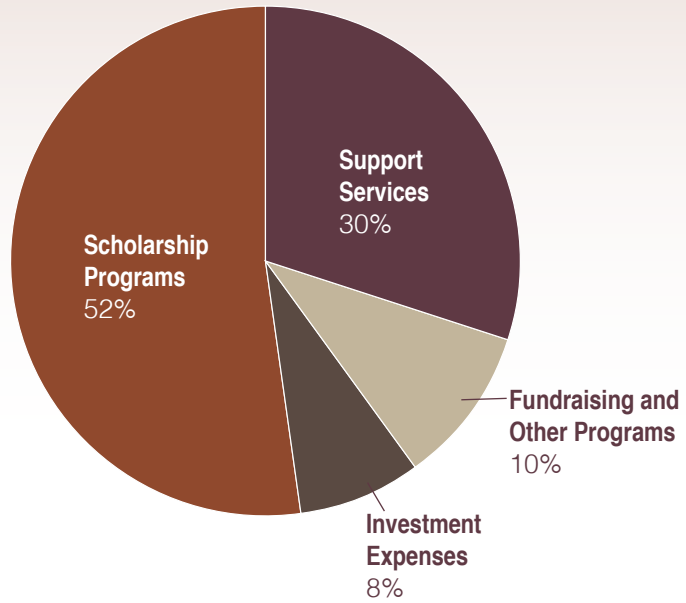

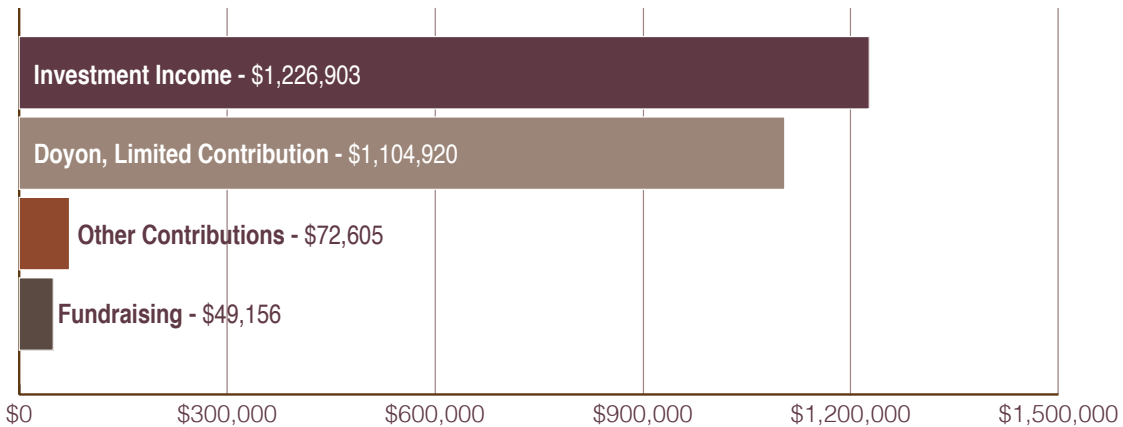
EXPENSES

Total Operating Expenses \$1,100,768

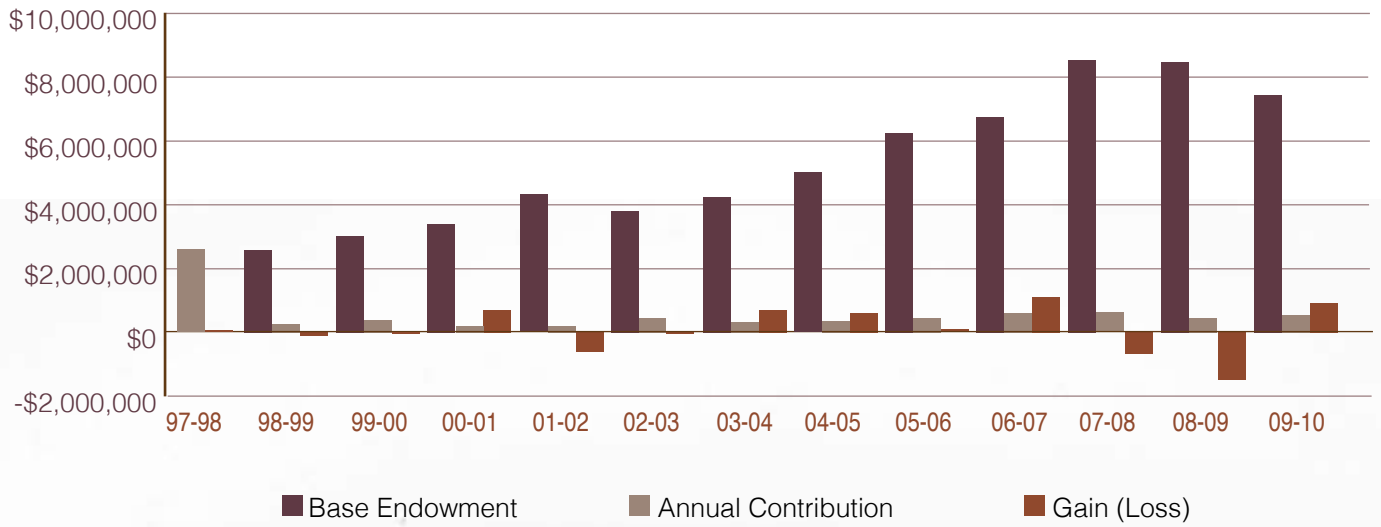


REVENUE
