We are pleased to share with you the Doyon Foundation 2018 annual report. For this report, we chose the theme "Faces of the Foundation," as it recognizes the many diverse and unique individuals who are part of our organization: board members, staff, committee members, language teams, volunteers, donors, students, alumni. Together, our efforts and involvement weave a beautiful tapestry that is the Foundation.

The "Faces of the Foundation" theme also acknowledges the different ways we work to serve Doyon shareholders and achieve our mission, specifically through our scholarship program and language revitalization program.

Finally, the theme highlights the fresh new face of the Foundation. In 2018, we developed and rolled out a refreshed brand for the Foundation and our language revitalization program/Doyon Languages Online project. This annual report reflects our new brand, which is also incorporated throughout our many other communications materials.

We continued the use of our new online scholarship application in 2018. After launching the online application portal in fall 2017, we've spent the past year refining the process and assisting students in using the new system, which has created significant efficiencies for our staff in terms of scholarship processing and reporting.

We made significant progress on our scholarship legacy data project in the past year, a time-consuming effort involving the manual entry of information on thousands of scholarship recipients from the past 20 years. The end result, however, is a rich database of historical scholarship information. The project has also provided us with a more accurate picture of our scholarship giving: Since inception 30 years ago, the Foundation has awarded more than \$10.6 million in scholarships to our students!

We also reached some noteworthy milestones with our language revitalization program and Doyon Languages Online project in the past year. We are in the process of wrapping up our Administration for Native Americans grant, which provided \$900,000 in funding for our Doyon Languages Online project over the past three years.

We will roll out the first set of Doyon Languages Online lessons this year, in partnership with 7000 Languages and utilizing software donated by Transparent Languages Online. We could not have accomplished this without the time and expertise of our teams of content creators and linguistics consultants. They have gathered regularly at the Foundation office, and it has been wonderful seeing them, watching them work, and hearing their stories.

This is a time of growth and momentum for the Foundation, and we thank our volunteers and our donors for their dedicated support. We look forward to continuing our work together to serve our students and strengthen our culture.




## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

# LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION

A growing focus area for the Foundation is language revitalization. In response to the endangered status of the 10 languages of the Doyon region, Doyon Foundation began laying the groundwork for a region-wide language revitalization program in 2009. In 2012, Doyon, Limited generously awarded start-up funding to establish the program.

Our language revitalization program has continued to build momentum in the past year, moving projects forward, bringing in new people, ideas and inspiration, and laying the groundwork for continued growth and development. It is a very exciting time.

Joining our language staff in the past year were Diloola Erickson, who is leading our Doyon Languages Online II project, and Jennifer Mayo-Shannon, our first-ever language revitalization program administrative assistant.

In addition to our staff, we are very appreciative of our language committee, which provides guidance on the work of the language revitalization program.



One of our primary focuses is the Doyon Languages Online project, an online language-learning platform for Doyon region languages. We are currently working on creating lessons for nine of the 10 Doyon region languages. The first five language courses are funded by a three-year, \$900,000 Administration for Native Americans grant. These courses will cover Holikachuk, Denaakk'e, Benhti Kenaga', Hän, and Dinjii Zhuh K'yaa. The next four language courses are funded by a three-year, \$977,423 U.S. Department of Education – Alaska Native Educational Program grant. These courses will cover Denak'i, Dihthâad Xt'een lin aanděeg', Née'aaneegn', and Deg Xinag. We expect to launch the first set of lessons in spring 2019.



We could not do this project without our software partners at 7000 Languages and our language teams. We contracted with individuals from each of the focus language communities to organize into language teams, which work collaboratively with Elders, linguists and the Doyon Languages Online development team to create the template curriculum and demos, and perform outreach for the project.




# **FINANCIALS**


#### **EXPENSES**

Total operating expenses for fiscal year 2017 – 2018 were just under \$2 million. The largest payouts were for the scholarship programs, followed by the language program, support services, and fundraising and other programs.



#### **BASE ENDOWMENT**

The endowment balance at June 30, 2018, was \$24,494,977, including the previous year's ending balance plus Doyon, Limited's endowment contribution and investment gains.

#### MORRIS THOMPSON MEMORIAL GOLF CLASSIC

Our largest fundraising event is the annual Morris Thompson Memorial Golf Classic, which takes place each year in June in Fairbanks. This special event, which marked its 18th year in 2018, raises money for the Morris Thompson competitive scholarship fund, while also honoring the memory of the late Morris Thompson. Since inception, the Foundation has awarded 193 Morris Thompson Memorial competitive scholarships totaling \$428,180. The 2018 event drew more than 100 golfers, 50 sponsors and more than 50 volunteers, while raising \$122,467, up from \$103,097 the previous year.

#### COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

In addition to the Morris Thompson competitive scholarship fund, we received some noteworthy contributions to other scholarship funds last year, including continued support for the Arctic Information Technology (AIT) and DesignData information technology scholarship and Tanana Chiefs Conference health scholarship. We were also thrilled to receive a significant new funding source for our lands and natural resource scholarship fund, plus the establishment of two new competitive scholarships: the Flannery and Schutt legal scholarship and the Fate leadership scholarship! We awarded the first scholarship from the new law fund this academic year to Niisha Walsh.

#### **NEE TS'EE NEEYH**

Nee Ts'ee Neeyh, or We All Give or Help, donations totaled \$18,658 last year. These funds include donations from individual donors, earnings from the Fred Meyer Community Rewards program, United Way contributions, and Pick. Click. Give. pledges.
