### SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a Doyon Foundation scholarship, applicants must:

- · Be enrolled to Doyon, Limited or be the child of an original enrollee. If applicant is not an original enrollee, but is the child of an original shareholder, an original birth certificate is required for verification. Gifted or inherited shares do not qualify an individual for scholarship eligibility.
- · Be accepted to an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school.
- · Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 for undergraduates, 3.0 for graduates or masters, and 3.25 for specialists or doctorates.
- · Be enrolled in 12 or more credits (undergraduates), or 9 or more credits (graduates) to be considered full-time students.
- Be enrolled in 3 to 11 credits (undergraduates), or 2 to 8 credits (graduates) to be considered part-time students.



### SCHOLARSHIP TYPES AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Doyon Foundation offers four types of scholarships, including:

### COMPETITIVE

Up to \$11,000\*\*

Awarded once per year

\*\* Amounts vary for special competitive awards, such as corporate-funded, field-specific and memorial scholarships.

### Competitive award applicants must submit:

- Online competitive scholarship application
- ☐ Signed release and consent form
- Online personal essay
- Official transcripts\* from last school attended or GED scores
- ☐ Proof of academic enrollment
- ☐ Two professional letters of reference (to be sent directly from the author to the Foundation)

**VOCATIONAL STUDENTS** enrolled in programs longer than 120 hours per semester are eligible for basic and competitive scholarships.

\* Official transcripts must be submitted the first time a student applies for a scholarship in an academic year, which runs August through July. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable for subsequent applications during the same academic year.

### PART-TIME AND FULL-TIME AWARDS

Range from \$1,600 for part-time students to \$2,400 for full-time students

Awarded three times per year

### Part-time and full-time award applicants must submit:

- Online scholarship application
- Signed release and consent form
- ☐ Proof of academic enrollment
- Official transcripts\* from last school attended or GED scores

### LEVEL UP SCHOLARSHIP

Covers the course or testing cost (up to \$3,000)

Awarded year-round

Students eligible to receive once per academic year

Can pay for LSAT, MCAT, GRE, GMAT and other required testing

### KICKSTART SCHOLARSHIP

Covers the course cost (up to \$400)

Awarded year-round to high school students taking college courses, if their school district does not offer funding

#### Level Up and Kickstart scholarship applicants must submit:

- Online application

- ☐ Proof of academic enrollment (must show enrollment, cost of the course/training and credits received)
- ☐ Original transcripts\* from the last school attended, GED scores (for Level Up applicants), or current official transcripts\* (for Kickstart applicants)

# APPLICATION PROCESS AND TRANSCRIPTS

#### **ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS**

Scholarship applications are only accepted online at *doyonfoundation.com/apply*.

Previous applicants can log in using their email and password. First-time applicants will need to create a new account.



Please do this well in advance of the scholarship deadline, as it can take several days to verify a student's shareholder status.

### **TRANSCRIPTS**

Official transcripts must be submitted the first time a student applies for a scholarship in an academic year, which runs August through July. For example, if the student applies in the fall, he or she must submit official transcripts. If the same student reapplies in the spring or summer of that same academic year, unofficial transcripts will be accepted.

Returning students are students who received a scholarship the prior scholarship period. The Foundation understands that sometimes grades/transcripts are not available until after the scholarship application deadline. In this case, returning students should submit all other application materials by the deadline, and then submit transcripts immediately after grades for the semester/term are available. The transcripts must show grades for the semester/term that the student received a scholarship for.
