How do I apply?

The application process for high school students is the same as all other Foundation students. Applications are accepted online through the Foundation's scholarship portal at *doyonfoundation.com/apply*. What do I need to apply?

For the High School Award, applicants must submit:

- · Completed online application
- Signed release and consent form (if under 18, parent or guardian must sign)
- · Current high school transcripts
- Proof of academic enrollment (must show enrollment, cost of the course/training and credits received)



When is the application deadline? Unlike our Part-Time, Full-Time and Competitive Awards, which have set deadlines, students can apply anytime during the year for a High School Award. These scholarships are awarded year-round on a first-come, first-served basis.
