HIGH SCHOOL AWARD

For high school students Up to \$1,000

High school students eligible to receive this award. Covers the actual cost of the course or program, not to exceed \$1,000. Funded on a first-come. first-served basis.



COMPETITIVE AWARD

Undergraduate or less

\$8.500

Graduate

\$10.500

Doctorate \$12,500

Awarded once per year to full-time, degree-seeking students. Students receive half the award for the fall semester and half for the spring.



PART- & **FULL-**↑ TIME-AWARD

Part-Time \$1.600

Full-Time \$2,400

Awarded three times per year to part-time and full-time. degree-seeking students. Students must submit an application for each semester they wish to receive funding. Funded on a first-come, first-served basis.



AWARD

For non-degree-seeking students Up to \$7.200

For non-degree-seeking students in programs, trainings or courses. It can also pay for LSAT, MCAT, GRE, GMAT and other required testing. Covers the actual cost, not to exceed \$7,200. Students eligible to receive multiple awards per calendar year.
