PART- & FULL-TIME POUNDATION AWARD SCHOLARSHIP

For part-time and full-time, degree-seeking students

Our Part- and Full-Time Awards:

- Are for degree-seeking students enrolled part-time or full-time at an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school
- Are awarded three times per year, for the spring, summer and fall semesters
- Range from \$1,600 for part-time students to \$2,400 for full-time students
- Are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible students

Who is eligible for a Part-Time or Full-Time Award? Applicants must:

- Be enrolled to Doyon, Limited or be the child of an original enrollee
- Be enrolled at an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school

Part time is considered 3 to 11 credits for undergraduates, or 2 to 8 credits for graduate students

Full time is considered 12 or more credits for undergraduates, or 9 or more credits for graduate students

- · Have a high school diploma or GED
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for undergraduates, 3.0 for graduate or master's, or 3.25 for specialists or doctorate students

How do I apply?

Students must submit an application for each semester they wish to receive funding. Applications are accepted online through the Foundation's scholarship portal at *doyonfoundation.com/apply*. - · Completed online application
- · Signed release and consent form
- Transcripts from the last school attended or GED scores
- · Proof of academic enrollment
