# LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION

The 10 ancestral languages of the Doyon region, including nine Athabascan languages plus Inupiaq, represent half of the 20 Native languages in state of Alaska. The Doyon Foundation language revitalization program is dedicated to revitalizing the Native languages of the Doyon region and helping endangered languages thrive for future generations.



### **DOYON LANGUAGES ONLINE**

To date, our Doyon Languages Online project has published courses in five languages: Benhti Kokhut'ana Kenaga' (Lower Tanana), Denaakk'e (Koyukon), Dinjii Zhuh K'yaa (Gwich'in), Hän and Holikachuk. These online language-learning courses are now available for free to all interested learners at doyonfoundation.com/dlo.

Efforts are underway to release courses in four more languages: Dihthaad Xt'een lin Aanděeg' (Tanacross), Deg Xinag, Dinak'i (Upper Kuskokwim) and Nee'aanèegn' (Upper Tanana). Watch our website and social media for updates!
