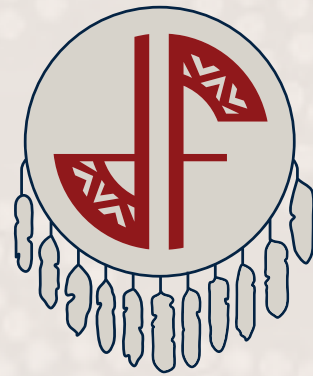

WELCOME FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear friends,

I was raised in Galena with my mom and my sister. After I graduated from high school, I moved to Fairbanks – a big change from my small hometown – to attend the University of Alaska Fairbanks. I didn't know the difference between a 100- and a 300-level course, and was overwhelmed by the process of registering, much less actually taking classes!

I called my mom and begged her to let me come home. But instead of a ticket back to Galena, I got a call from the then-executive director of Doyon Foundation, Kathy Mayo, who asked me to have lunch. Her words gave me the encouragement and direction I needed to get on the path to my college degree. I remember thinking to myself that, one day, I wanted to give back like Kathy did for me.

My college journey didn't follow a traditional four-year path. Life got in the way, as I am sure many of our students past and present can understand. With a family emergency, a failed semester, juggling school and work, and getting student loans, it took me 12 years to get my degree. But I did it, thanks to the many people who supported me along the way.

After my degree, I spent eight years at the Interior Regional Housing Authority, moving from property manager to COO, before accepting an offer at Tanana Chiefs Conference (TCC) for a position that I was nervous about because I didn't know if I was capable. I remember then-president Jerry Isaac

encouraging me, "There are people here that support you and want you to succeed." His words gave me the courage to take the leap and I spent the next eight years at TCC.

Support has been a common theme throughout my education and my career. I have seen over and over again that people want to help me succeed. And I, in turn, want to help other people succeed.

When I saw the executive director job opening here at Doyon Foundation, I remembered what I told myself all those years ago. This was my chance to give back, to help today's and tomorrow's students reach for their goals.

I am so honored to be in this important role, supporting students and alumni, and strengthening our language and culture. The Foundation already does so much for our people, and I am excited about the opportunities to grow and do more.

I thank you for your support of the Foundation and for believing in the future of our students. I look forward to seeing what we will accomplish together.

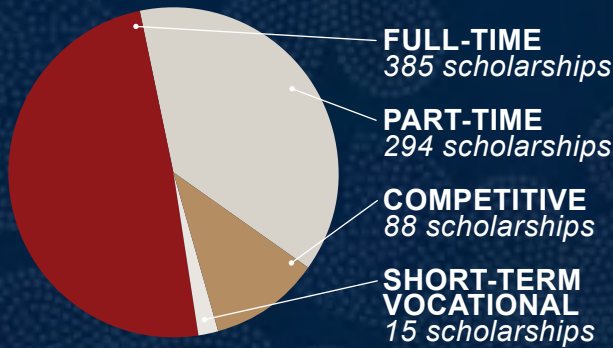

LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION

The 10 ancestral languages of the Doyon region, including nine Athabascan languages plus Inupiaq, represent half of the 20 Native languages in state of Alaska. All of these languages are severely to critically endangered.

Through our language revitalization program, we continue to work with individuals and partner organizations to ensure the Native languages of the Doyon region survive – and thrive – for current and future generations.

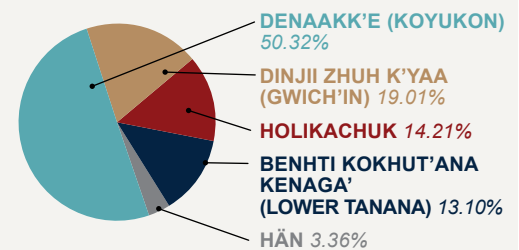
In partnership with 7000 Languages, we are developing and offering online courses in nine of the Native Doyon region languages. These courses are available for free to all interested learners.

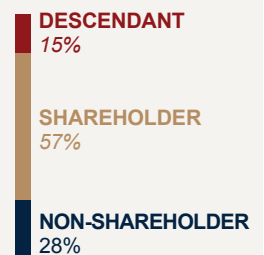

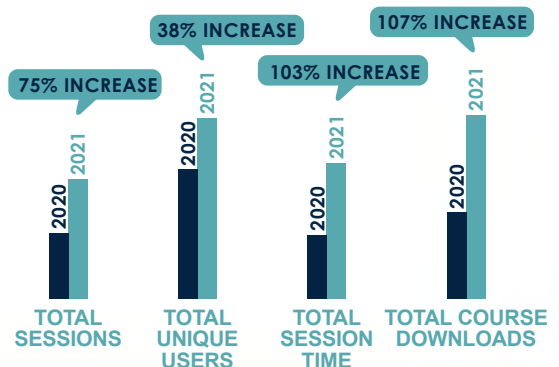
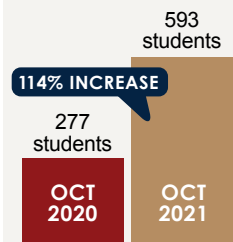


DLO ON THE GO CONTEST

Thank you to all the students who participated in our DLO On the Go contest, which was intended to increase the number of students and the amount of time spent learning in Doyon Languages Online. From October 2020 to October 2021, we saw a 114 percent increase in the number of students. During the contest, there was a 75 percent increase in total sessions and a 103 percent increase in total session time.



NUMBER OF STUDENTS

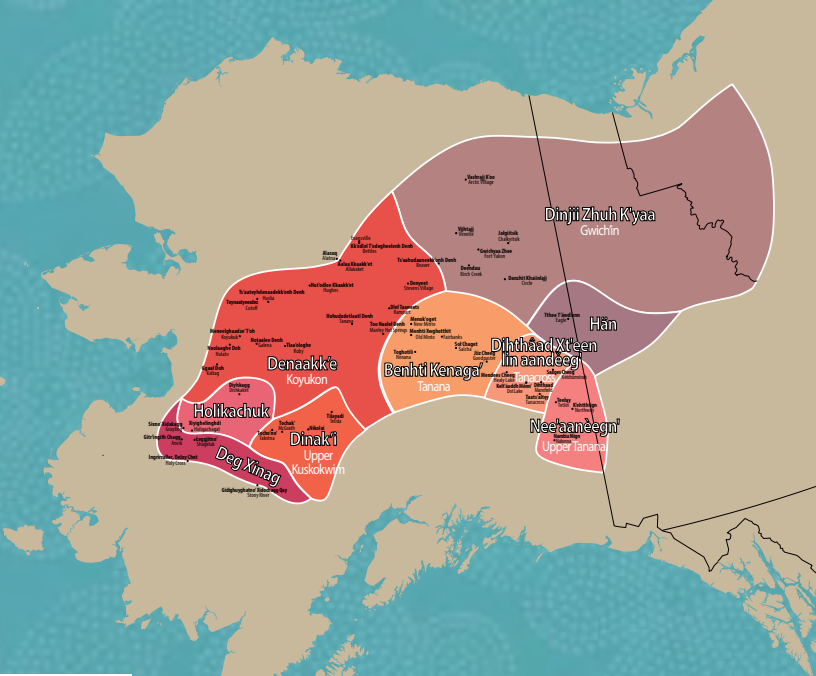


Data from March - September 2020 vs. 2021

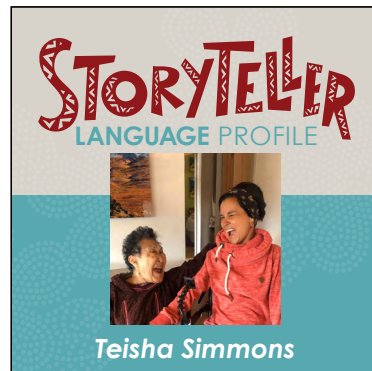

MENTOR-APPRENTICE PROGRAM

In 2021, our language team applied for and received a three-year, \$812,142 grant from the Administration of Native Americans to fund a new mentor-apprentice program designed to increase the number of Doyon shareholders who can speak – and teach – their Native language. 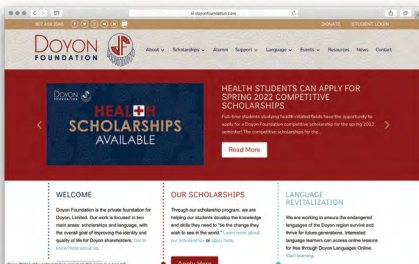
