For full-time, degree-seeking students

Our competitive award:

- Is for students enrolled full time at an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school
- Is awarded once per year; half is distributed for the fall semester and half for the spring semester
- Ranges from \$7,000 for undergraduates, to \$9,000 for graduates, to \$11,000 for doctorate students
- Recipients are selected through a review and scoring process by an independent committee

Who is eligible for a competitive award?

Applicants must:

- Be enrolled to Doyon, Limited or be the child of an original enrollee
- Be enrolled full time at an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school

Full time is considered 12 or more credits for undergraduates, or 9 or more credits for graduate students

- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for undergraduates, 3.0 for graduate or master's, or 3.25 for specialists or doctorate students

In a non-degree-seeking program?

If you are an eligible student in a non-degree-seeking program, check out our Level Up scholarship! We also offer a Kickstart scholarship for high school students taking college credit.

How do I apply?

Applications are accepted online through the Foundation's scholarship portal doyonfoundation.com/apply. Note that first-time applicants will need to create a new account, and that it can take up to three business days to verify a student's shareholder status.

Note that students do not apply for specific competitive awards. Applications are categorized by staff based on a student's field of study, class standing and/or degree program.

What do I need to apply?

For the competitive award, applicants must submit:

- Completed online application
- Signed release and consent form
- Original transcripts from the last school attended or GED scores
- Proof of academic enrollment
- Personal essay
- Two letters of recommendation



When is the application deadline?

May 15 is the deadline to apply for a competitive award for the next academic year. Note that competitive award recipients who are funded for the fall semester must reapply for spring semester funding by the November 15 deadline. Essay and letters of recommendation are not required for the spring application.
